
COMMUNITY CONNECTIONS

A REENTRY RESOURCE GUIDE

Community Connections is a resource guide intended for formerly incarcerated people reentering Ontario, Wayne, Wyoming, or Livingston counties from correctional facilities.

Libraries offer free access to information, including books, educational materials, computers and the internet, and often provide career development and more. 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ESSENTIALS

Having essential identification documents can significantly benefit you in various aspects of life, such as securing employment, obtaining housing, and accessing other important services.

Social Security Card – 1-800-772-1213

NYS Driver's License OR Non-Driver ID Card

To apply for a Permit, Driver's License, or Non-Driver ID Card in New York State, you'll need to complete Form MV-44 (available online at dmv.ny.gov/forms/mv44.pdf). Filled applications must be submitted in person at a DMV office, along with original documents proving your identity (see the comprehensive list at dmv.ny.gov/forms/id44.pdf).

Birth Certificate

Application must be submitted with copies of either A or B:

- A. One of the following forms of valid photo-ID: Driver's license; State-issued, nondriver photo-ID card; Passport; U.S. Military-issued, photo-ID.
- B. <u>Two of the following showing the applicant's name and address:</u> Utility or telephone bill; Letter from a government agency dated within the last six months.

Reapply to Vote - 1-800-367-8683

If you are actively incarcerated for a felony, you cannot vote in any elections. In New York State, the right to vote is automatically restored after release, meaning you must reapply to vote.

To apply to vote, or to reapply to vote, follow the steps laid out on https://elections.ny.gov/voter-registration-process, or call 1-800-FOR-VOTE (1-800-367-8683) to request a voter registration form.

EDUCATION

SUNY HEP (Higher Education in Prisons) and REJI (Rochester Education Justice Initiative)

SUNY Genesee Community College (GCC) and the University of Rochester (U of R) have partnered to offer free college courses to individuals currently incarcerated at Attica, Groveland, and Wyoming Correctional Facilities. This program is open to those with a GED or high school diploma. Upon release, formerly incarcerated students can continue their education at U of R through the Justice Scholars Program (https://www.sas.rochester.edu/reji/programs/justice-scholars.html) at no cost.

If you are currently incarcerated in Attica, Groveland, or Wyoming Correctional Facilities, ask your facility's librarian for more information on SUNY HEP and REJI.

EMPLOYMENT

Documentation

To increase your chances of successful employment after incarceration, having specific documents and following certain processes can be beneficial.

Certificate of Relief / Certificate of Good Behavior

Certain felony and misdemeanor convictions may restrict eligibility for specific types of employment or licenses. Obtaining a Certificate of Relief or Certificate of Good Behavior can help restore these eligibility requirements. This applies to professions such as security guards, private investigators, insurance brokers, certain civil service positions, etc.
